(The herald looks to see if any other herald has their staff raised. If so, the herald waits. When no other staff is raised, the herald raises his/hers and says the following:)

Herald: _____ and _____, arm and report to field _____.

(The herald lowers his/her staff.)

(Ask the Marshal if the fighters are ready.)

(When the Marshal indicates the fighters are ready. . .)

(The herald looks to see if any other herald has their staff raised. If so, the herald waits. When no other staff is raised, the herald raises his/hers and says the following:)

Herald: In the ___th round of the Coronet Lists of the Principality of Cynagua,
_____ and _____ do meet in honorable combat.

(The herald lowers his/her staff.)

Gentles, salute the Coronet.

You may salute the one whose favor you bear.

Salute you each your honorable opponent.

On your honor, and for the Coronet of Cynagua, LAY ON!

(Leave the field immediately.)

(When the Marshal has indicated the victor. . .)

(The herald looks to see if any other herald has their staff raised. If so, the herald waits. When no other staff is raised, the herald raises his/hers and says the following:)

Herald: Victory to _____

*(The herald lowers his/her staff.
